God's Open Invitation

John 3:3 - "Very truly I tell you, no one can see the kingdom of God unless they are born again."

Jesus' words in this scripture is a direct invitation for experiencing Christ's love, forgiveness and grace. We know the "born again" is not about a physical birth, it's all about our heart, it's all about waking up the spirit inside us! New seasons can be in the form of life, faith, or even the season of nature. The John 3:3 scripture is a powerful promise of renewal, or perhaps a new connection to Christ through any of the seasons.

Rebirth signifies a fresh start, a clean slate, and an opportunity to embrace the abundant life that Jesus offers. It's a reminder that no matter where we are in our spiritual walk or what mistakes we've made, God's grace is always available to us, always renewing us. This fresh start (even if it is everyday) gives us the chance to let go of things from the past that we regret and instead walk in the freedom Christ has given us- *free by the way, didn't need to pay a dime for it!*

In Isaiah 43:18-19, God speaks directly to His people, encouraging



them to let go of the past: "Forget the former things; do not dwell on the past. See, I am doing a new thing! Now it springs up; do you not

perceive it?" Did we hear the call to leave behind the weight of old wounds and struggles?

BOLD WITNESS

Spirit & Truth

Matt Reynolds, founder of Spirit and Truth, experienced a life-changing conviction that shifted his ministry focus from managing church programs to actively engaging with people beyond church walls. This transformation led to the creation of Spirit and Truth, a ministry dedicated to equipping Christians to live as everyday missionaries by following the Holy Spirit's guidance.

Reynolds emphasizes that evangelism isn't about using scripts or polished techniques but about being sensitive to the Spirit's leading. Reflecting on the story of the woman at the well (John 4:1-42), he highlights the need to meet people where they are and speak with grace and love. Reynolds teaches that starting small, trusting the Holy Spirit, and approaching others with a heart of love are key to meaningful spiritual connections.

John Wesley's journey in embracing field preaching serves as a foundation for Spirit and Truth's mission. Wesley initially resisted preaching outside the church but eventually stepped beyond traditional spaces to reach people where they were, sacrificing comfort and reputation for radical obedience to God. This approach became central to early Methodism, planting churches and spreading revival across communities. Reynolds echoes this mindset today, urging Christians to shift their focus from internal programs to empowering members to serve as missionaries in daily life. He reminds believers that "one



minute with the Holy Spirit is far more effective than 1,000 minutes of human effort." Through Spirit and Truth, Christians are encouraged to listen for God's voice, trust in His leading, and share His love in simple, powerful ways.

At Spirit and Truth, Reynolds leads a global movement to see the church fully alive– empowered by the Spirit, rooted in truth, and mobilized for mission. The ministry engages in this vision through three core areas: Equipping, offering regional conferences and local church weekends to spark new growth; Resources, providing podcasts, articles, and theological materials like Firebrand Magazine; and Global Partnership, supporting church-to-church missions, global church planting, and pastoral training. This holistic approach equips believers to live out their faith boldly and authentically.

By reclaiming the church's evangelistic DNA and trusting the Holy Spirit, Spirit and Truth inspires believers to be bold, compassionate, and obedient in guiding others toward Christ.




How do I know if a Stephen Minister is for me?
