LAMENT: COMPLAINT OR CONCERN?



Jesus' lament over Jerusalem is both an expression of love and a prophetic warning. He knows that the city will not accept Him and will ultimately lead to His death. Yet, despite this rejection, His love for the people remains and He just really wants to protect them all. And this city, the people he loves so much chooses their own path instead of embracing His offer of refuge and grace.

Things to think about this week:

1. When we feel heartbreak, from situations and things that happen- pray from the bottom of our hearts in a lament to God.
2. When we experience rejection from those we love or that we are close to- remember that Christ too experienced rejection, pray a lament to God for consolation. And #3-
3. See and be open to a lament as an invitation for a response of Concern from God, not us just complaining.

To lament with prayer is not just expressing our sadness or grief. We are also acknowledging that God is at work even when things seem broken and out of control. We can trust that He is moving us toward a greater purpose, just as Christ was moving toward Jerusalem and the cross.

Thank you, Jesus, for your journey – thank you for your indescribable love – thank you for the gift of salvation, because you cried over and with us.
