# How Much Does That Cost? John 12:1-8

Mary's intimate act of pouring perfume on Jesus' feet was costly on many levels. She broke the social norm prohibiting public touching between men and women, and the cost of the perfume is substantial. John associates the anointing of the feet as the love and respect for the Messiah.

However, annointing the feet was odd because people often anointed a person's face, so that they would have a pleasant scent, but John goes on to describe how the room was filled with the sweet smell (John 12:3), as the woman washes Jesus' feet out of her love for him, and the whole room can experience that love through smell.

John's gospel carefully includes parts from Mark's gospel text, linking the anointing to the death and burial of Jesus. Mary and her sister Martha (along with many others) had just recently witnessed the raising of Lazarus- and whether she really understood fully what she was doing, Mary now prepares Jesus for death. Judas is only worried about the money that was spent on the perfume and now wasted.... but really it was about how he's losing out – Mary on the other hand is also preparing Jesus to share **the fullness of LIFE with everyone** - Mary's perspective comes from a realization of LIFE THROUGH CHRIST following her brother being raised from the dead!! Like Mary's perfume, true love leaves traces. It is a love that does not make worldly sense, yet it is the very foundation of our faith.

Love: How Much Does It Cost? How can we be more like Mary, to pour love onto those around us? Love is rarely grand or performative—it is often found in the small, hidden acts that reflect the heart of Christ. It is found in our willingness to serve, to give, to let go of what we cannot control, and to trust that what we pour out in love will never be lost.

Love: How Much Does It Cost? The Cost is Jesus' ultimate act of love—his death. The Payoff? Christ's Resurrection and Eternal Life for Everyone who accepts Christ as their Savior.

Extravagant cost? You bet it was—and I mean on both Mary's anointing and moreover Christ's life FOR US!

Love-How much can we spend?
